Eligibility

This program is open to all international students who have completed at least one semester in college or university.

Students who are nominated by PNU's exchange partner universities or APRU member universities will get a 20% discount as a scholarship from the regular fee.

The program fee includes Gimhae international airport round pick-up, textbook, Korean classes, cultural activities, field trips, special lectures, ceremonies and accommodation(including breakfast and lunch.)

PNU on-campus dormitories are fully equipped with twin beds (two students per room). 
